Karri is naturally good-looking and the use of natural oils helps bring out its even, interlocking grain and rich textures.

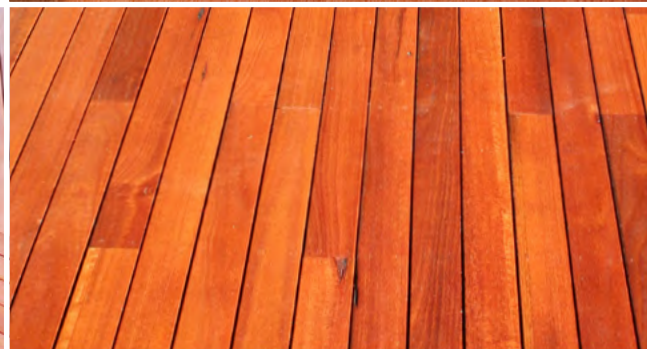
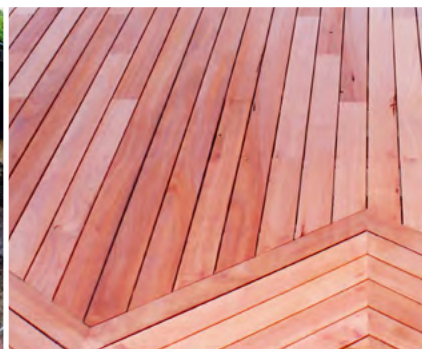
Karri grows straight and tall in its natural environment and this uniformity can be used to great effect on new decks or those being integrated with classic renovations.
